


Dear Parents,

# **Art Supplies K-6**

If you are a returning family, you do not need to purchase new art supplies with the exception of a **NEW box** of washable Crayola markers and refreshing items such as new scissors if your child's scissors are now too small/dull.

Please put all of these art supplies in a Ziploc bag and write the child's name on it. If you have more than one student in K-6, siblings are welcome to share art supplies.

All **new** students, please bring the following:
